All puppies showed some very nice work, and where a handler and dog team ran into bad luck, that was only on the day! **ALL** puppies graduate into Advanced Pre-Kindy! **Congratulations!**

**What is the judge looking for?** We hope to see the handler and dog working as a team. The handler will give clear commands and signals, the dog will respond willingly and without hesitation. In the Pre-Kindy Class we use food in the graduation. The handler should give clear signals, may lure with the empty hand, and **MARK the correct response** with GOOD, YES, or CLICK. Never together, for then the food would block the MARKER which predicts the FOOD.

It is that rush of expectation that enables the rapid learning! **Recall Highlight:** The dog needs to run off, **AWAY** from the boss, before he is called! **THIS** pattern creates obedience to the Recall!

The dog needs a pass in every points exercise and at least 85/100 to qualify. Under 85 = NQ

**The Targeting Touch: 15.** To the value of 5 points each, we wish to see 3 motivated touches!

**Heel on Lead: 30,** We wish to see the dog heel with drive and attention. We need to see the right positioning of the dog for the various moves. Were the turns tight and motivated? How was the timing of the Marker sound and the treat if used? Use of food leads to a 2 point deduction, so we hope that our handlers have learned to work with a Jackpot at the end of the exercise, and no luring except for an empty handed prompt.

**Recall: 15** Lead dropped, sit/stay, Recall. Every aspect of the Recall and handling counts.

**Temperament Test 15:** Judges' choice, of walking through a group or handler examining dog.

**Voice and Signals 10:** Clear and precise, Signals have been shaped out of luring moves.

**Dumbbell Play: graded .** Dog to interact with the owner, and happily give up his prey.

**Sit or Down Stay 15 ,** judges' choice, is a Group Exercise, 30 secs at 5m distance.

Test: full marks! Voice and Signals: 9 /10 Dumbbell Play: graded Very good. The Stay exercise also gained full marks, well done! Judges' Comment: Dog was sniffing, surging, and went wide on the turns. However, this dog and handler can do well, recommended they go up into Kindy Class.

Judges' Comments: Lee needs to work in a brisk manner. Hand signals need to improve. There is an overuse of the dog's name. Pup has high drive and will be a lovely, lively worked when Lee has a little more training under his belt! Recommended to Kindy Class. **Scored: 58 NQ**

Voice & Signals: 2/10, Dumbbell Play: Excellent! Sit or Down Stay: 0 /15. Judges' Comments: Working dogs need to be worked briskly. There should never be a tight lead. Handler still needs to learn stand and down signals. The dog mouthed several people in the crowd. Owner needs to be shown a better way. **Scored: 27 NQ**

**KINDY CLASS: Judged by: Kerrie Pearce, 4 entered, 1 qualified, Pass Rate: 25%**

**Number entered: 4**      **Number Passed: 1**      The dog needs a pass in every points exercise and at least 85/100 to qualify. If the dog does not meet these minimum requirements, there will be a Non Qualifying score, denoted as NQ. The exercises are:

**Heel on Lead, 30**, including all paces, positions and turns. The judges are looking for a loose leash, the dog at handler's side with attention, maintaining good positioning on the turns, not forging on the straights, with fast responses to give straight sits, stands and downs!

**Walk through Crowd: 10** We need to see the dog relaxed and unconcerned, under control and not jumping up at folks. **Food Manners 5:** After the excitement of being walked through the group, the dog needs to have enough impulse control to refuse the food offered.

**Sit for Examination, 15.** The dog will be at handler's side, or in front, Judges' choice.

**Recall: 20**, off lead, from 6 to 8m distance. We hope to see a fast, happy recall with Present!

**Dumbbell Play is graded.** All the way from Poor, to Good, Very Good and Excellent!

**Sit Stay 10**, at 6m, for 30 secs, lead dropped. We expect a steady stay without fidgeting.

**Down Stay 10:** at 6m for 60 seconds, lead dropped. Again, calm behavior should gain a pass.

This test includes a fair amount of testing on everyday living skills. Of course the loose leash walking that our dogs mastered in Pre-Kindy and Advanced Pre-Kindy, is now a little more demanding, please read the Heel on Lead

description at the top of this page, and picture your own dog offering this behaviour! Walking through a crowd and Food manners are equally important, for your dog must always be on its best when out in public, so practice the good behaviour, highly rewarding all good work! Dogs that love sit for examinations, will love pats by the public! A pretty sight, dogs loving being loved up! Our Recall is a life-saver! Dumbbell play, balls, tuggies, all play in prey drive will be of great benefit in your training, for it can be the gateway to motivated heeling and Recalls! Stays should be happy, used to create calmness!

**CLASS ONE: Judged by: Jean McCowan 7 entered, 6 passes, Pass Rate: 85.8 % WOW!**

The dog needs a pass in every points exercise and at least 170/200 to qualify,.

We hope to see the dog working with drive and Attention, showing a great Attitude and considerable Accuracy – yes, a Triple A Dog is desired!

**Heel on Lead 30:** The lead needs to be loose, showing a small loop, with the dog maintaining the heel position with attention, responding happily to all commands, whizzing around the left and right about turns, holding the correct heel position for the sits, stands and downs, and presenting a picture of smooth team work on the change of pace. The left and right turns need to be sharp right angle turns. Ideally the dog is watching the handler!

**Stand for Examination 20:** On judges question: “Are you ready”? Our handler should quickly check his dog’s positioning, and as he replies YES, the dog is alert and ready to earn praise! He will stand straight and steadily under examination, enjoying the attention, but standing firm until he is freed on Judges’ order: Exercise Finished.

**Recall: 20** This will be from 10 to 12 metres distance for a fast Recall & smart Present.

The dog must sit steadily whilst the handler returns around the back into heel position.

**Food Manners:** are graded. Our dogs see food refusal as part of the **NRM**, so it’s a cinch!

**Down From Free** is graded: We are looking for a good signal and command, fast response!

**Dumbbell Play** is graded: By now our dogs are generally retrieve fanatics and love the chase!

**Sit Stay 15** at 6-8 metres for 30 seconds and **Down Stay** at 6 – 8 metres for 60 seconds.

Any dog passing this level of training has proven to be a pretty good companion, and is ready for the owner to enter trials classes, where the happy team will work towards their CCD, which is the next level, Community Companion Dog. If you have passed today, CONGRATULATIONS! If you missed out, well, there’s time for improvement with another term of Happy Training!

The dog needs a pass in every exercise and score at least 85/100 to qualify. Before every exercise, the judge will ask: Are you ready? This is not a signal to perform a little honey bee mating dance, getting the dog to run rings around the handler and finally sit, hopefully straight, but your chance to glance at your dog, check that he is sitting straight and beam: YES! Your dog will be ready to sparkle! Why? Because that YES, is a promise of good things to come!

**Heel on Lead: 30** Here's what the judge will ask the dog and handler team to exhibit for their heel routine: The judge will order Forward, Halt, stand, down, fast pace, normal pace, slow pace, right turn, left turn, right about turn, left about turn, figure 8, lead out, Exercise finished. These commands may be given in any order and repeated. Going through our classes, our handlers are well prepared for all of this, and we should see high drive dogs prancing!

**Deductions:** A dog that is unmanageable will score 0. If the handler continually tugs on the lead, adapts his pace to the dog, constantly guides the dog with the lead, loses over 50% .

Minor **deductions** are made for failing to sit, stand or down, poor sits, downs, stands, and occasional guidance with the lead, for double commands and other minor imperfections.

**Stand for Examination 20:** Judges; Orders: Forward, Stand your dog. Here we wish to see a smart stepping off, a clear, calm signal to stand, and a team standing side by side, straight and proud, waiting for the order: "Leave your dog" upon which the handler will walk to the end of his at least 75 cm lead, and turn to stand facing his dog whilst the judge, who had approached from the left or right front, will examine the dog's head, and body. On the order Return to your dog, the handler returns, stepping around his dog who holds his position, standing at the dog's side until on Judges order: Exercise Finished, at which point the handler may praise his dog. These are not 20 easy points! We require precision and good handling!

A dog that attacks scores zero. Minor deductions for a dog that requires a 2<sup>nd</sup> command to stand, moves its feet, poor stands or failing to carry out some lesser points of the exercise.

**Recall 20.** Orders are: Take up position, Leave, About turn, Halt, Call, Exercise Finished. Here we see some lovely work, with handlers stepping off smartly, coming to a smart halt, confidently commanding their dogs to stay, stepping off without hesitation, about turning on Judges' command, halt and awaiting permission to call their dog. The dogs, keenly awaiting this call, will come flying in and sit in front! The Judge orders Exercise Finished, and the handler can beam with joy, and praise his dog! It's a great exercise!

Deductions: Zero score for dog breaking from position, not coming on first command, or anticipating the command to come. Substantial deductions for slow response to commands and for failure to come at a brisk pace. Minor deductions are made for failing the automatic sit, failing to sit in front or poor sits. Also for failure to leave a pause between the dog's name and the command to come.

**1 min Sit Stay and 2 min Down Stay, each 15**, should be full marks with calm and steady stays. The distance is approximately 10 metres, and the dogs are well accustomed working in a group for the Stays. The handlers are calm and confident, and leave & return together.

A dog that breaks from position or moves more than ½ its body length scores zero. Minor deductions are made for a dog that fidgets, or for a dog rolling into the dead dog position.
