

## State Breed Exhibition Graduation Report. 14/4/2019

**This was the 2<sup>nd</sup> time** that the GSDA of WA had conducted their SBE Graduation on the week before the main event, the SBE Show and Trial held over 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of April.

The benefit was less distraction for the young dogs and relatively new to competing handlers being able to work without the distraction from the Show Ring that the Trials Dogs had to ignore on the following Saturday, and the disadvantage, was the fact that the competing dogs could not be listed in the main catalogue, together with the Critique Only classes.

This being said, we are planning to have one closing date of entries for all next year, so that although spread over two weekends, we still have the unity and greater feeling of belonging that has, over the decades, been so much a part of the State Breed Exhibition!

Now let us look at the Graduation Results for our Junior Classes, where we can see how much our members have taken the advice of their trainers to heart, and practiced with their dogs, to demonstrate in their tests, that they have achieved a good understanding of how to communicate with, and effectively train their lovely young dogs! Many have achieved all that, but on the day, fell victim to their own nerves, which will in return cause the dog to do his best to calm down his nervous partner, his loving owner, and the dogs will do this by dropping their heads and sniffing the ground – a canine invitation to relax and smell the roses!

We had an overall entry of 31, a pretty good effort in all!

**Judges' overall comments:** The results are a credit to the Pre-Kindy trainers, for the majority of the class had scored excellently in at least 3 out of the 7 exercises, with a good number scoring a VG in 4 or 5 exercises, along with a sprinkling of work that was overall Good. The one exercise where we saw a problem arising, was the STAYS, where 7 pups scored a P for poor, meaning they broke their stay. Although P for Poor means the dog did not qualify in that exercise, there was some lovely work in the other sections, and all puppies that are old enough, 5 months or older will go into Advanced Pre-Kindy, where working with Karen, they will be working on more every day life exercises with the aim of advancing into Kindy Class at the following graduation.

Would not stay today. **Scored: 1 Exc. 5 G., 1 P NQ**

Walk on loose lead: 15/30, G., Pup’s position was good, Taneeka’s lead handling also good, as was the timing of marker. Two sits: VG, well positioned,. Nice clear command and signal, when the timing becomes more practiced, the pup will respond more quickly! Two downs: G, these were sit-downs, Two Stands: P. Puppy Recall: P. would not return. Play VG, Sit or Down Stay, 30 secs at 3m. P. would not stay today! **Scored: 2 VG, 2 G, 3 P NQ**

### **ADVANCED PRE-KINDY CLASS: Judged by: Kym Glenny**

**Number entered: 3                      Number Passed: 2                      Pass Rate: 66%**

The dog needs at least 50% in every points exercise and at least 85/100 to qualify,.

**Targeting Touch: 15** Show us your dog’s enthusiasm and drive with 3 touches of any style! It might be left hand or right, may be high or low, or even on the move!!

**Heel on Lead: 30,** We wish to see the dog heel with drive and attention. We need to see the right positioning of the dog for the various moves. Were the turns tight and motivated? How was the timing of the Marker sound and the treat if used? Use of food leads to a 1 point deduction, so we hope that our handlers have learned to work with a Jackpot at the end of the exercise, and no luring except for an empty handed prompt.

**Recall: 15** Lead dropped, sit/stay, Recall. Every aspect of the Recall and handling counts.

**Temperament Test 15:** Judges’ choice, of walk through a group or handler examining dog.

**Voice and Signals 10:** Clear and precise, Signals have been shaped out of luring moves.

**Dumbbell Play: graded .** Dog to interact with the owner, and happily give up his prey.

**Sit or Down Stay 15 ,** judges’ choice, is a Group Exercise, 30 secs at 5m distance.

Temperament Test:Full marks, 15/15, Voice and Signals: 10/10, Retrieve: graded: Exc. Sit or Down Stay: Full marks, 15/15. **Scored 97/100, that’s EXC!**

**KINDY CLASS: Judged by: John Glenny**

**Number entered: 3 Number Passed: 1 Pass Rate: 33%**

The dog needs a pass (50%) in every points exercise and at least 85/100 to qualify,.

#### **THE EXERCISES ARE:**

**Heel on Lead, 30**, including all paces, positions and turns. The judges are looking for a loose leash, smart 90 degree turns, close about turns, the dog at handler's side with attention, maintaining good positioning with fast responses to the stand and down given with voice and signal, together. The sit from Kindy Class onwards, is automatic when the handler halts!

**Walk through Crowd: 10** We need to see the dog relaxed and unconcerned, under control and not jumping up at folks. **Food Manners 5**: After the excitement of being walked through the group, the dog needs to have enough impulse control to refuse the food offered.

**Sit for Examination, 15**. The dog will be at handler's side, or in front, Judges' choice.

**Recall: 20**, off lead, from 6 to 8m distance. We hope to see a fast, happy recall with Present!

**Dumbbell Play is graded**. All the way from Poor, to Good, Very Good and Excellent!

**Sit Stay 10**, at 6m, for 30 secs, lead dropped. We expect a steady stay without fidgeting.

**Down Stay 10**: at 6m for 60 seconds, lead dropped. Again, calm behavior should gain a pass.

### **1<sup>st</sup> and only qualifier: Dina Mistry with VOLSCARO GIORGIO ULTIMATE**

Heel on Lead: Generally good work with minor deductions, 20 /30. Walk through Crowd: scored full marks! This means the dog was nice and relaxed, behaved well, and Dian showed good leadership. 10 /10. Well done! Food Manners: 2/5 were there a NRM and another minor deduction perhaps?? Sit for Examination: Full marks! 15/15 Recall: Full marks! Well done! 20/20. Dumbbell Play is graded Exc. Sit Stay: both stays scored full marks! Well done! Imbue the heeling with joy, Dina, and the scores will soar into the higher range!

**Scored 87/100 Good.**

Heel on Lead: Overall good work, with the occasional tight leash, extra commands, and slow sits. 20/30. Walk through Crowd: Full marks: 10/10, Food Manners: UhOH! NRM to control the impulse to sniff the food and some lesser deduction! 2 /5 Sit for Examination: Lovely, dog is happy and relaxed, does not fidget! 15 /15 Recall: Full marks again! 20 /20. Dumbbell Play is graded. Good. Broke the Sit Stay: 0/10, Full marks for Down Stay: 10/10: there was a score of 77 – 5 for some unnamed deduction. Quintana requires further work, does not sit??

Heel on Lead: 15 /30 .A difficult start, with many extra commands, some crooked sits and downs. Losing 15 points on the heel work means Bruno needed full points in everything else in order to qualify. Walk through Crowd: Yes, this scored full marks! 10 /10. Food Manners: 2 /5 OOPS! That brought his score down to below qualifying. Bruno needed a NRM to stop sniffing, and another minor deduction. Sit for Examination: Full marks, 15/15 Recall: Lovely, full marks again, 20 /20. Dumbbell Play is graded VG, Sit Stay: OOPS, broke from position 0/10, Down Stay: not very certain of his stays, it seems, scored 5/10, gaining a 50% pass for the down stay. Overall very promising work, Natasha, with some joy in the heel work, and stays, you should do well next term and graduate with flying colours! **Scored: 67/100 NQ**

**CLASS ONE**            **Judged by: John Glenny**

**Number entered: 6   Number Passed: 4   Pass Rate: 67%**

The dog needs a pass in every points exercise and at least 170/200 to qualify,. We hope to see the dog working with drive and Attention, showing a great Attitude and considerable Accuracy – yes, “ **A Triple A Dog** “ is desired!

**Heel on Lead 30:** The lead needs to be loose, showing a small loop, with the dog maintaining the heel position with attention, responding happily to all commands, whizzing around the left and right about turns, holding the correct heel position for the sits, stands and downs, and presenting a picture of smooth team work on the change of pace. The left and right turns need to be sharp right angle turns. Ideally the dog is keenly watching the handler!

**Stand for Examination 20:** On judges question: “Are you ready”? Our handler should quickly check his dog’s positioning, and as he replies YES, the dog is alert and ready to earn praise! He will stand straight and steadily under examination, enjoying the attention, but standing firm until he is freed on Judges’ order: Exercise Finished.

**Recall: 20** This will be from 10 to 12 metres distance for a fast Recall & smart Present. The dog must sit steadily whilst the handler returns around the back into heel position.

**Food Manners:** are graded. Our dogs see food refusal as the **NRM game**, so it’s a cinch!

**Down From Free** is graded: We are looking for a good signal and command, fast response!

**Dumbbell Play** is graded: By now our dogs are generally retrieve fanatics and love the chase!

**Sit Stay 15** at 6-8 metres for 30 seconds and **Down Stay** at 6 – 8 metres for 60 seconds.

Any dog passing this level of training has proven to be a pretty good companion, and is ready for the owner to enter trials classes, where the happy team will work towards their CCD, which is the next level, Community Companion Dog. If you have passed today, CONGRATULATIONS! If you missed out, well, there’s time for improvement with another term of Happy Training!
