20 Matters referred by Member Clubs to the AGM

20.1 <u>Motion</u> - <u>Moved</u>: <u>GSDCQ</u> <u>Executive required to breed under guidelines as per Breed Surveyors</u> and Judges.

"That as of 2021 the GSDCA elected Executive members be required to breed under the guidelines set down for GSDCA Judges and Surveyors"

Rationale

Those individuals putting themselves forward to be elected to a position on the GSDCA Executive should be setting the standard for the membership and the ideals set forward by the council for our breed improvement schemes. A person who stands in one of these positions should set an example for the membership across Australia and for those people who serve the council as recognised GSDCA judges and surveyors.

A person who stands for any Executive position who is not prepared to breed within these requirements should not be elected as they are not demonstrating the ideals of the Council.

20.2 Motion - Moved: GSDQ - 2 Breed Surveyors at Small Club Surveys

"The rule that requires a minimum of 2 Breed Surveyors to adjudicate at breed surveys is rescinded."

Rationale

The Executive of the GSDCA put this rule in place without it being put to an AGM of the GSDCA in the required constitutional fashion. That is, there was no due notice afforded to clubs to consider the motion, no motion was placed and voted on at an AGM and therefore the rule is unconstitutional and therefore invalid.

20.3 Motion: - Moved GSDSA - Criteria and Eligibility to Participate

"Rescind Clause 4.10 – Animals born after 1 July 2018 to be classified at breed survey must not have linebreeding closer than (3-3). Accepted linebreeding is (2-4; 4-2; 3-3; 2-5; 5-2 or wider) [2019] Animals born prior to 1 July 2018 must not have any linebreeding closer than (3-2) or (2-3)"

Rationale

This motion was introduced as part of the WUSV Harmonisation program. No scientific evidence was presented to validate the effect of this change. No evidence was presented to show any detrimental effect of 2-3 or 3-2 line breeding on the Breed. The WUSV in their own Breeding rules allow 2-3 or 3-2 until 2025.

- 20.4 Motion: Moved GSDSA Specialist Judges & Aspiring Specialist Judges, Breed Surveyors and Aspiring Breed Surveyors.
 - a) "Rescind Clause 6.1 and 6.2" Current Regulations:

That as of 1 July 2019 all GSDCA Specialist Judges and Aspiring Specialist Judges must sign the following GSDCA Service Agreement (Ver07/2019) (refer Appendix 9.3.1) to maintain their GSDCA Specialist Judge status. [2019].

b) "Rescind Clause 6.3 and 6.4"

Current Regulations:

Effective the 1 July 2019 all GSDCA Breed Surveyors and Aspiring Breed Surveyors must sign the GSDCA Service Agreement (Ver 07/2017) (refer Appendix 9.3.1) to maintain their GSDCA Breed Surveyor Status. [2019]

- c) "Rescind Current Regulation Clause 6.5"
 - 6.5 GSDCA Aspiring Specialist Judge/Breed Surveyor, GSDCA Specialist Judge/GSDCA Breed Surveyor Review, Investigation, Disciplinary and Appeal Procedures. [2020]

<u>Ration</u>ale

This is a draconian regulation and goes against the GSDCA Inc objective of Breed Improvement.

Not even the SV have a regulation that comes close to this restrictive regulation. The regulation has been proven to be ineffective as the agreement is poorly worded and, in the cases, where investigations have been instigated, they have been unsubstantiated.

Owners of stud dogs are placing the animals in the names of children and spouses to get round the regulation. Kennel prefixes are being transferred into name of a single owner to avoid the regulations.

One investigation failed due to poor wording of the agreement and the failure of the Executive to properly endorse the document.

Second investigation again failed due to poor wording and the threat of legal action.

Third investigation failed due to stud dog owner having no control over semen once it was sold.

Fourth investigation was not investigated as per the regulations and threat of legal action.

This regulation has merely created an opportunity for Judges and Breed Surveyors to become creative in circumventing the regulations.

22 General Business

22.1 <u>Discussion items - Moved GSDCQ</u>

Clubs give due consideration and discussion to the value and benefits received for the annual payment made by the GSDCA to be a member of the WUSV. That is; what is it exactly that the GSDCA and its Member Clubs receive for the annual subscription it pays and what are the obligations imposed on the GSDCA and its Member Clubs by being a member of the WUSV?

Rationale:

A considerable annual fee is paid by the GSDCA to be a member of the WUSV. Clubs have been subjected to WUSV/SV demands and even threats of WUSV member disaffiliation which has caused considerable acrimony between members, clubs and the GSDCA. There are clearly a great many members of clubs in Australia who do not know what it is that the GSDCA receives as a benefit for its annual fee, do not know what the legal commitment is of the GSDCA being a WUSV member nor what the implications would be if the GSDCA was not a member of the WUSV.

RESUME - NATIONAL BREED COMMISSION CHAIR - Mr. IAN URIE



My name is Ian Urie, and I have been involved with German Shepherd Dogs since 1982 as an owner, show exhibitor and breeder, and I dare say I am known to most people in the fraternity Australia wide. I have bred and shown many dogs that have been successful at National level and have regularly exhibited and judged at shows all over the country.

I have been a member of the GSD Club of Victoria for 38 years. In 2004 I was honoured with Life Membership, and in 2015 was presented with a GSDCA Service Award. I have spent more than 30 years serving as an instructor and on committees of one sort or another for my Club, including Branch Committees, Breed Affairs Committee and Show Committee with 11 years as Show Manager, and chaired the organizing committees for three National Shows and two Main Breed Exhibitions. I have acted as interim Shepherd News Editor, Assistant Branch Manager, CWA Registrar and Rehoming

Officer on occasions and was a member of Dogs Victoria's Canine Legislation and Welfare Committee for 9 years with 4 years as Chairperson. I have also served on the GSDCV Management Committee for 15 years - 3 years as a Branch Manager, and served 5 terms as Victorian Breed Affairs Administrator, and 7 terms as a Vice President of the GSDCV.

I have held a GSD Championship judging licence since 1996, qualified as a GSDCA Specialist Judge in 2000, and was appointed as a Breed Surveyor in 2005. I have had an active interest in National Council affairs for a long time. Over the last 20 years I have attended the Council's AGM and Breed Commission Meetings at every opportunity, as an interested observer and support for my Club delegate, and as a Breed Surveyor.
