All puppies graduate into Advanced Pre-Kindy with the older dogs. Bumbags and Head Halters or Harnesses are permitted, as that is how the family pet will be walked in the streets. Ideally the empty handed signals will bring the desired response, which is marked and rewarded. Luring with food Brings a 1 point deduction for each instance.

From 2019 onwards, all puppies advance from the Socialisation and Games Beginner's Class to Pre-Kindy Class. At the end of the term, Pre-Kindies will be promoted to the Advanced Pre-Kindy Class. For the Competitive and most skilled handlers, there is the **Pre-Kindy Graduation!** **Magnificent trophies and lovely rosettes can we won at the CCT, so you need to be in it to win it!**

Retrieve or Tug: VG, pup happy to interact with handler, pounced and grabbed with enthusiasm, happy to release. Walk on loose lead: Another pretty nice performance, 27 /30 gaining an EXC. The 2 sits and Stands well positioned, with Gilbert giving clear signals, and VG timing, were VG. Two downs with Larnie in the right position at the start, and clear signal, dropped to a Good because of the timing, Every aspect of the Puppy Recall was EXC.. Puppy Recall: Khaila did not know the "Off you go", so could not run off in order to be called back to show the Recall, but distance was created, G. Retrieve or Tug: Happy to interact, but lacked enthusiasm, G. Stay, 30 secs at 3m:G. **Scored: 1 Exc, 2VG, 4 x G.**

Walk on loose lead: Positioning VG, lead handling was G, but lead was tight. Major was attentive and timing was VG, 26/30, VG. Raine ran into bad luck on this day and gained a NQ score. Let me tell you a little more about the name of this lovely bitch and her titles. As in all canine performance sports, in Obedience and in Rally O' (Rally Obedience) too, **the title gained goes behind the dogs name.** Only the highest title is listed in each sport. So when a dog gains, and is granted, the Community Companion Dog Title, the CCD, he may be entered in Novice class with his name and the CCD title attached to it, until he gains his CD title. Once that title is granted, the dog may compete in the Open Class, with the letters CD attached to his name. The CCD is dropped, it has been superceded.

On gaining the CDX title, the CD is dropped from the name. And so on, until finally **the dog that has gained the Championship Title in any of the disciplines, will have the CH title in front of his name!** Read all about it in the "Conduct and Rules for Obedience Trials" in the link given above!

The GSDCA has various breed improvement schemes in place, and these too are given behind the dog's name, all except the asterisk *, **which stands for Breed Survey Classified** and automatically denotes hips and elbows of a standard deemed suitable or even recommended for breeding! If there is any abbreviation in any report that puzzles you, ask your Obedience Instructors, Judge or Breed Surveyor. I think Diane will forgive me for giving you all the info in this paragraph under her lovely Raine's name, for in this very successfully campaigned multi discipline trained breed surveyed show dog, we see a lot of what we could all aim for, in the one package! Having gained the UD title AND a further 5 qualifying certificates of 185 points or better gained in the UD ring, this time under THREE different judges, the handler may apply for the granting of the Obedience Champion Title for this dog. The O.CH. title goes before the dog's name.

It will be seen in the next two competitors' results; in the higher still UDX class, that not only do we have top performers with highly trained and beautifully performing dogs in our Trials Classes, but the elite, so well known in Perth Clubs winning circle, too know that apart from all the training, the joy, the thrills, the jubinations, the spills, there is also a need for that elusive little bit of luck to make a great day perfect!!

UDX class is open to any dog that has gained the UD title and is the highest class in Obedience.

In the UDX class too, a dog may continue to compete indefinitely, and some dogs compete in two classes on the same day, although in hot summer trials this is not generally advised except for the most energetic and highly motivated dogs. Many competitors will chose to compete in Open and UD, or Open and UDX class, but at the Closed Club Trial we always expect the hottest days, and recommend entry in one class for the thrill of seeing the dog at his or her best!

On having gained the UDX title AND a further 2 qualifying certificates of 185 points or better gained in the UDX ring, under 2 different judges, the handler may apply for the granting of the Obedience Champion Title for this dog. The O.CH. title goes before the dog's name.
