On her 3rd confident cast, to no avail as she would not go beyond the line of the decoy, we gave assistance in order to retain the keenness of search and confidence. Positions in Motion was performed with smoothness and style after the initial slight hesitancy on the first sit. 35/40. Scent Discrimination – Judges' Scent was well performed with a thorough search, minor deduction for picking up and immediately dropping an article before final selection, 24/30. Directed Send Away and Recall, failed to go the full distance. 0/30. On the Distance Control the 2nd and 4th change of

position were incorrect. Would have preferred the dog to be praised heartily for performing moves 5 and 6 which were shown with aplomb.

Multiple Retrieve: Correct

gloves with deductions for crooked and slow sits and finishes. Movement on the Group Examination scored a minor deduction. A generally smooth, working team.
